## Asthma case

Miss JK is 16 years old and weighs 40 kg.

Presenting Complaint (PC): She was admitted to hospital 5 days ago with an asthma attack

**History presenting complaint (HOPC):** Prior to admission she had 3 days of possible upper respiratory tract infection (URTI) symptoms (runny nose, cough, a bit of slightly yellow sputum, sore throat, myalgia)

Past Medical History (PMH): She has had asthma since she was 8

Medicines History: Her usual medication prior to admission was:

Salbutamol inhaler 200 mcg ( puffs) prn Fluticasone Accuhaler 250 mg (1 puff) bd Theophylline 200 mg PO twice bd (Reserve oral steroids)

Allergies: aspirin

The following medications have been added in hospital:

Prednisolone 25 mg PO bd Amoxicillin-clavulanic acid 250/125 mg PO tds Metoclopramide 5 mg PO prn (up to tds)

- Q1. What could have brought on Miss JK's asthma attack?
- Q2. What investigations/results would you look for in her medical notes?
- Q3. What medications would have been used to manage her asthma attack?
- Q4. Comment on the use of metoclopramide?
- Q5. What counselling would you give this patient?
